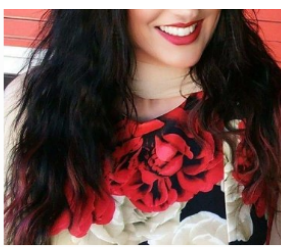


Victoria Hartmann
